school to an A school. Improvement was seen in all areas—science, language arts, math. Increases in every demographic area. Gaye has met with each department focusing on essentials, better planning, teachers pick their students for PLUS time, changing attitude about testing, and better testing environment. The school is thrilled about the growth results and the growth is across the board.

In the Utah Middle School Report-out of 208 middle schools in Utah CMS was 17th in the state....moved up 92 spots since last year! We are celebrating the "A" school status but work still needs to continue to keep the "A" school status.

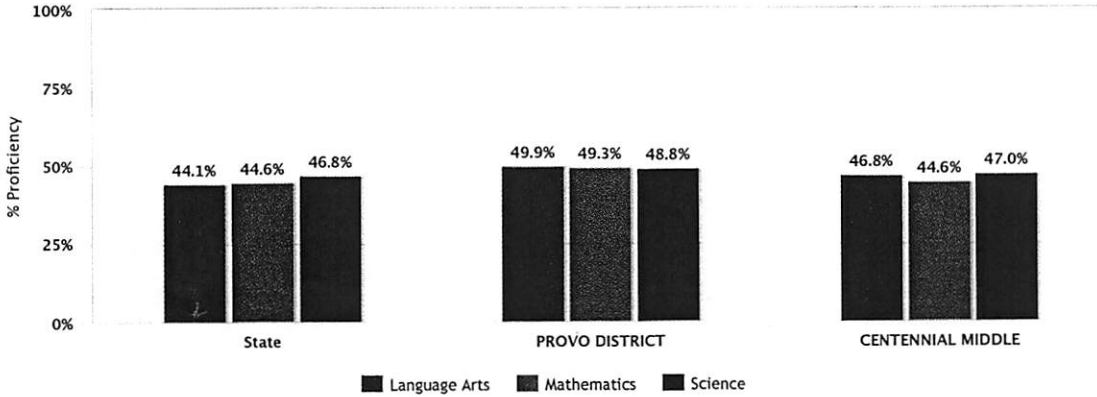

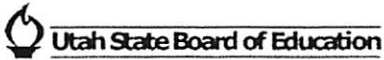

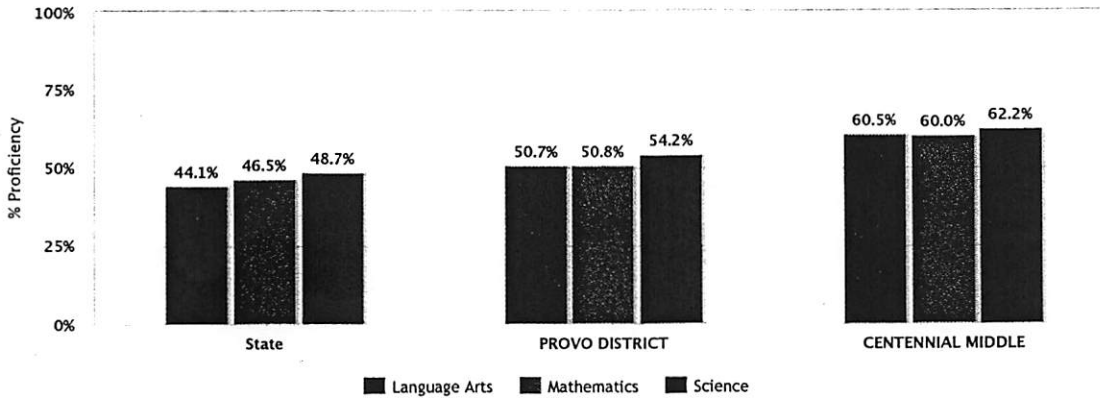
