MINUTES OF THE MEETING:

Gaye welcomed everyone.

Gaye went over suggestions for **Trustland Funds**. According to the Trustlands, the funds should go to the greatest academic needs that the school has. Gaye outlined the following needs and the needs included:

\$60,000.00 – To be used to hire 4 Instructional Aides to assist teachers. 1 for Michael Austin’s class and 3 Instructional Aides to be used to assist teachers in Math and Science.

\$10,000.00 – To be used for books for English classes.

\$10,000.00 – To be used for Teachers Professional Development.

TOTAL \$80,000.00
