Review Amendment to 2017-2018 Plan

The amendment was to use \$10,000.00 carry over funds to hire 2 ESOL Aides to help ESOL students. They (along with 1 other ESOL Aide) will be assigned to help students with assignments, translating, etc.

The amendment was approved by the district and the school board. We have hired 2 ESOL Aides and they just have started working.

An idea was brought up about having an ESOL class after school for those students who would like extra help. It could be started to see if there was an interest. Even offering incentives-like pizza-to encourage students to stay. Kyle will look into the possibilities of starting this class.
