



DEAR PARENT OR GUARDIAN:

Provo City School District is hosting a SightBuddies event, sponsored by CharityVision International on **October 27th, 2017** at Utah Valley Eye Center in Provo.

SightBuddies is a FREE event that provides qualifying students with a free eye exam from a state-certified optometrist during school hours. Students will be bused to Utah Valley Eye Center for the exam. If the exam indicates that glasses are needed, students will get to choose a pair of glasses. Most students will be able to take the glasses home the same day, but some prescriptions may require lab work and be delivered to the school two weeks later.

Qualified students are defined as students who meet at least one or a combination of the following requirements:

- 1) Did not pass the school-wide vision screening and rescreening by the school nurse
- 2) Qualify for free or reduced lunch
- 3) Have no vision insurance OR have vision insurance but have otherwise been denied access to visual healthcare
- 4) Students with broken or lost glasses may be eligible. Talk to your school nurse for approval.

Please complete the attached permission form and return it to the health clerk or school nurse. All permission forms are due **before October 13, 2017**. If we do not receive enough permission forms to have the event, your student will be seen on the next SightBuddies event in the fall.
