Dear Parent/Guardian & Student:

Enclosed in this folder, you will find registration materials for Centennial Middle School. Please look over these materials carefully. The course description booklet contains a short description of required and elective classes offered at CMS.

You are invited to attend our **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent Night at Centennial Middle School on Wednesday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, from 6:00-8:00pm.** Parents of English Language Learners are invited to attend a special meeting at 5:30pm in room 44 to learn about the English Language Development program. We will begin in the auditorium and discuss some important information regarding your incoming seventh grade student. We will then have several breakout sessions you can attend including music and dance classes, honors and gifted classes, and Dual Language Immersion Chinese, French and Spanish classes. You will be able to meet teachers and ask questions about any concerns that you may have. You will also be able to tour our school, practice opening lockers, and meet our administrators, counselors and other school staff.

**Wednesday, February 26<sup>th</sup>** will be our **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Day** for the **2020-2021** incoming seventh grade students. School buses will bring students to Centennial Middle School around 12:50 p.m. Students will participate in four different rotations including Music, Dance & Theatre, School Tour, and a brief assembly with our Administration. Buses will return students to their elementary schools before school is out for the day. In order for your student's schedule requests to be considered, **completed registration materials must be returned to their sixth grade teacher no later than February 28<sup>th</sup>.**

*\*Please note there are immunization requirements for all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students entering middle school in the state of Utah for 2020-2021 school year. **Proof of immunization is required before school begins in August.** If possible, please turn in proof of immunizations to the main office at your **Elementary School** for documentation before school is out in May. Immunization records can be turned in to the main office at Centennial Middle School anytime the school is open throughout the summer.
