Safety Concerns-Rebecca Weaver

We are discussing the safe routes plans. Specifically the proposed crossing at Canyon Road and 350 East by the new Fire Station.

This is the location where most students prefer to cross. The city has already begun counting cars to assess the needs of a crossing of some sort. The Fire Station has budgeted for a flashing light sign that will activate when a fire truck is on the move. Can we upgrade this to a Hawk Crossing? Can we d a school crossing? How many children need to use the crossing? 10.

A Hawk Light is \$100,000-\$200,00.

Alternating Lights are \$20,000-\$40,000. (these are the lights by. The Provo Rec. Center)

Next Steps: Update safe routes map to show desired crossing and route. Community Council will submit Safe Routes to School District by March 30. The they will send it to the city. From there the city will decide what can be done based on number of crossings, number of cars, speed of cars.

Sargent Orgill stressed that even with crossings parent education is key. We need parents to teach their kids about safety.

Someone suggested that for CMS students a PLUS class lesson on the safe routes might be effective.
