Overview of what community council does-Lisa Jensen

Community Council has three main areas of responsibility:

- 1. Internet Safety and Digital Citizenship
- 2. School Safety and Safe Routes to School
- 3. School Improvement Plan (How to spend the School Trustland's money in a specific, measurable, and timely way)

In 2019-2020 there was approximately \$160-170,000. In 2020-2021 there is approximately \$187,000

Things the Community Council has used the money for in the past: Teacher Mini-Grants Teacher Training (Conferences etc.) Behavioral Incentives Instructional Aides Chromebook Carts

Digital Citizenship:

PTA is having White Ribbon week in January. No assembly this year but the school has purchased a virtual assembly from NetSmartz. Link can be sent to each student and they can watch during lunch one day.

School Safety:

There is a new city planner so we are back to square one with the cross walk on Canyon Road. The traffic light on 2320 N Is not happening the city was unable to acquire the property.

Does the school has everything it needs safety wise for Covid 19? Yes the School Board and District have provided sufficient supplies.

Trustlands Report:

We had \$14,000 carryover from last year. This year we have estimated expenses of \$170,000 in the School Plan, we may need to make some amendments to the plan. We may not need a Chromebook cart since this year we have gone one to one with Chromebooks. We are looking to have \$17,000 carryover this year. We can make more amendments to the plan or carry it over. As the school year continues we will monitor needs.

We will send an email to the teachers letting them know that we have 20 \$350 mini-grants available.
