MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 28, 2015

1) Introduction of Council Members:

Each Council Member introduced themselves to the group.

Gaye expressed her committed to turn the school around with tools like the Reading Plus Program. She also handed out the chart showing "Hess' Cognitive Rigor Matrix & Curricular Examples." Gaye explained the chart and where CMS is and where we need to be. She is excited to work with the teachers, student, and parents to accomplish this.

5) AMENDMEND FROM LAST YEAR PLAN:
