Digital Citizenship:

School Safety:

Rebecca Weaver (parent) presented on the possibility of a safe crossing on Canyon Road and approximately 350 N. She has done a lot of research and met with the Fire Chief, City engineers (Penrod) and Provo Police. There is a need for a safe crossing but the hoops to jump through are going to take some time. Rebecca has looked at Hawk crossings. They use them in Tucson Az with great success. Next month Sargent Orgill and Mr. Penrod will be at the meeting to discuss further how the community council and city entities can work together to get a safe crossing at this location.

Trustlands Funds:

Looking ahead to next year as we begin writing the plan the budget is anticipated to be around \$150,000.

The reading Plus site license is good until 2022 and so we do not need to budget for that. Things that are in the current year that are working and helping students improve are the funding of the ESOL Aides. Our ELL WIDA scores have improved significantly since increasing the help we give our ELL students. Instructional Aides allow for more small group teaching and interventions. They help in Math, Science and English classes and the teachers can focus on differentiation more because of the support from these aides.

We will send a 2-3 question survey to our parents to see what they like about what is happening at Centennial and where they think we can improve so that we can get a good idea of what the needs are as we proceed with next year's plan.

For next month's meeting we will cover this year's plan and begin work on next year's plan.
